The battery lights will get switched off when we close and put on again when we open.

Your display could be an advertising opportunity or you could let your imagination and creativity run wild! Each display should be labelled with the organisation's name and perhaps a short explanation or even a poem! The names will also be listed in the programme and there will be a raffle, activities for children and refreshments will be available throughout the weekend.

We are hoping for the support of as many village organisations as possible to make it a festival to remember. Above all, this should be a magical start to the Christmas season.
